- 1. Where are we going?**
 - We are visiting 6 schools in Southern California. We will be on a charter bus in close quarters and then at hotels in the evenings.
- 2. What is the cost to students?**
 - FREE. There is no cost to students for participating.
- 3. Do I have to bring money?**
 - Only if you want to purchase souvenirs at the various campuses, otherwise everything is pre-paid.
- 4. Can I have my cell phone on the trip?**
 - Cell phones will be collected by your E.L.E. in the morning and returned in the evening after night activities.
- 5. Can I bring a camera?**
 - YES! Bring a camera for day tours of the campuses to share your experience later. Remember your cell phone camera cannot be used.
- 6. What are the dates of the program?**
 - It is a 4-day program (see exact dates on the flyer).
- 7. How much walking am I doing?**
 - You will be walking up to 3 miles in a day, so wear comfortable shoes!
- 8. Will a student still be completing academic work?**
 - Yes, all students complete 2.5 elective credits of academic work and will have scheduled time and support to complete this work.
- 9. What can you expect to learn from this experience?**
 - Students will return with knowledge of college admissions, financial aid, college systems in California, a sense of worthiness, and an understanding that college is in their reach! Students will also work in teams and participate in self-discovery.
- 10. What activities will students participate in?**
 - Students will be participating in the daily life of a college student, including a variety of activities such as: campus tours, group games, college panels, eating in cafeterias, attending athletic events, and self-reflection activities. Students should also prepare to complete a workbook of activities to receive credit.
